### EVAC complete toilet modules on board of the New Generation Rollingstock (NGR) trains in Queensland, Australia.

In December 2017 the first of totaling up to 75 new six-car electric trains started passenger service in South East Queensland, Australia. In order to meet the growing demand for rail services the Queensland Government has invested in the New Generation Rollingstock (NGR) project.

Major concern has been to offer the passengers safer and modern trains. 35 NGR trains will be equipped with toilet facilities. EVAC has designed and produced the complete toilet modules in the NGR fleet, which service all lines in South East Queensland. Numerous customizations and special requirements were implemented in order to increase the cruising comfort and safety for passenger. A baby changing table with especially high stability for easy and safe baby care and a special emergency exit in the toilet door are just two examples for passenger comfort, state-of-the-art design and convincing technology.



The trains are built by the Bombardier leading consortium Qtectic. They were designed in Queensland and assembled in Savli, India. Once assembled, each NGR train travels via cargo vessel from the Port of Mumbai to the Port of Brisbane.
